

5th Annual Donkey Welfare Symposium- Call for Research Abstracts

We would like to invite researchers, practitioners, sanctuary managers, and scientists to submit a project abstract for the 5th Annual Donkey Welfare Symposium. The abstract should be written in English and be no longer than 500 words (excluding names and affiliations). Each presentation should contain a title, an introduction to the study with aims and objectives, methods, results and interpretation. The research topic should contribute to the mission of the 5th Annual Donkey Welfare Symposium; “To promote best practice for donkey care and welfare needs, to share knowledge and to set standards for the promotion and enhancement of donkey management worldwide.” Abstracts that are accepted will receive an invite to participate in a poster session. The two best abstracts selected by the scientific committee will be invited to present as oral presentations at the symposium, and will receive a scholarship to travel to the University of California, Davis, for the meeting November 3,4, and 5 of 2017.
